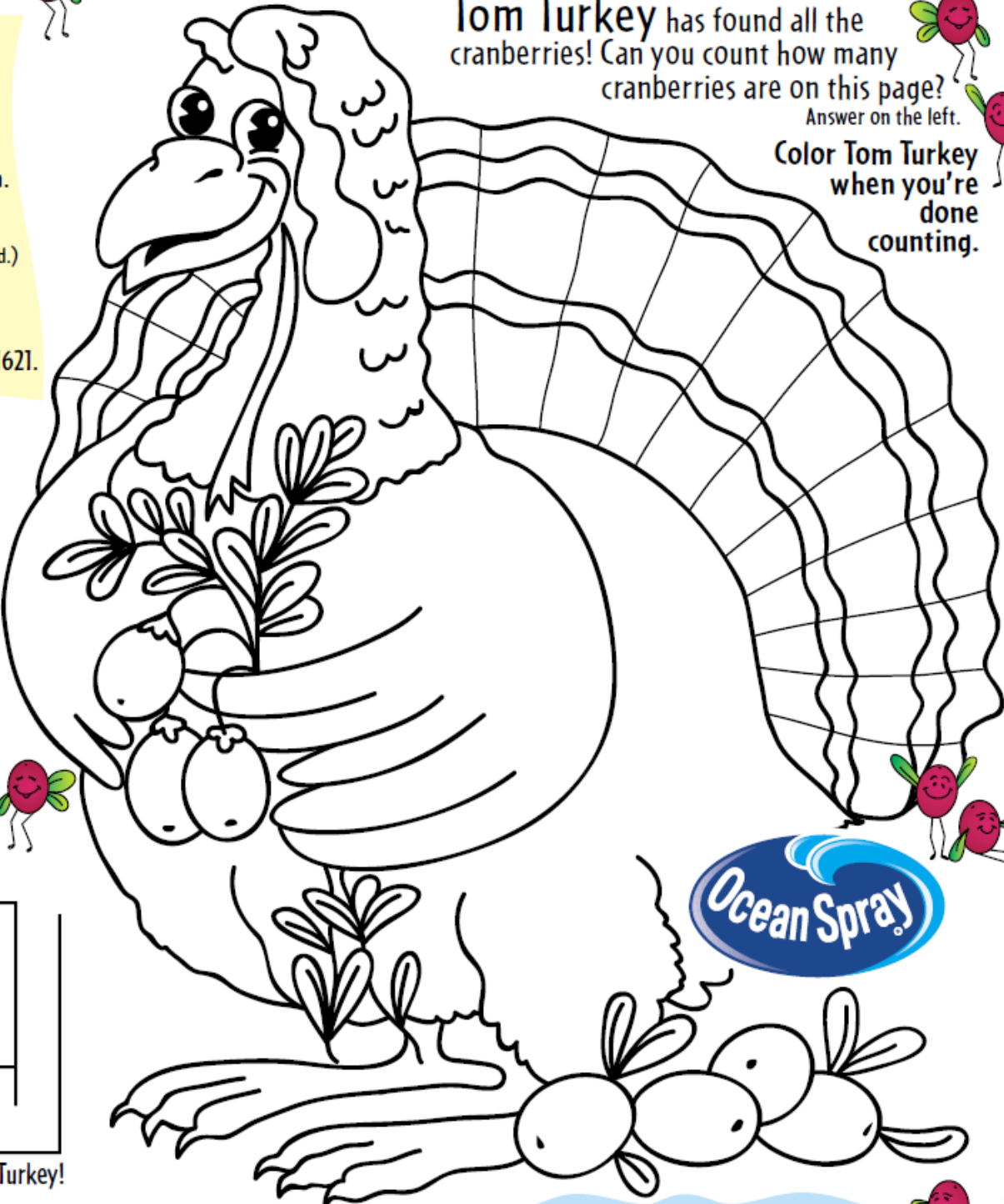

Cranberries are a fruit and one of only a few native to North America. (Others are blueberries and Concord grapes.)  
 There are about 100 varieties of cranberries.  
 It takes about 200 cranberries to make one can of sauce.  
 10.8 Billion cranberries are consumed each Holiday Season.  
 That's a whole lot of cranberries!  
 Cranberries grow in bogs.  
 (A bog is a cranberry bed made up of layers of clay, gravel, peat and sand.)  
 Bet you didn't know that cranberries bounce and float!  
 Pockets of air in cranberries help in harvesting and selecting the very freshest ones.  
 Cranberries were served at the very first Thanksgiving in 1621.

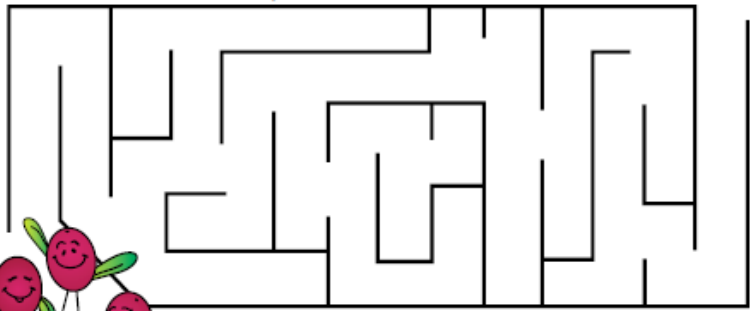
